Day 3, Tuesday



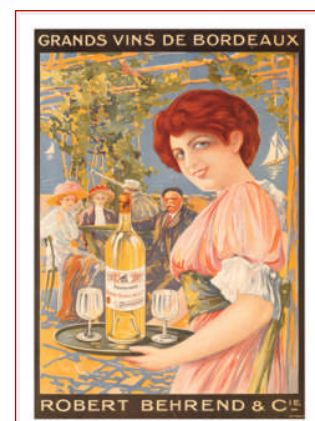

Day 7, Saturday

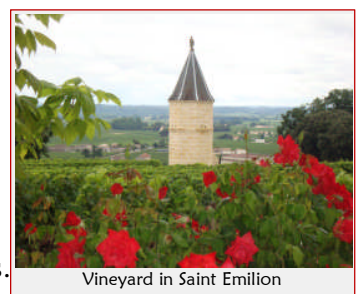
Departure today after breakfast if you can bear it, or stay another day to prolong the enjoyment and visit the renowned St-Emilion region with us.
